## WHAT DID YOU HEAR?

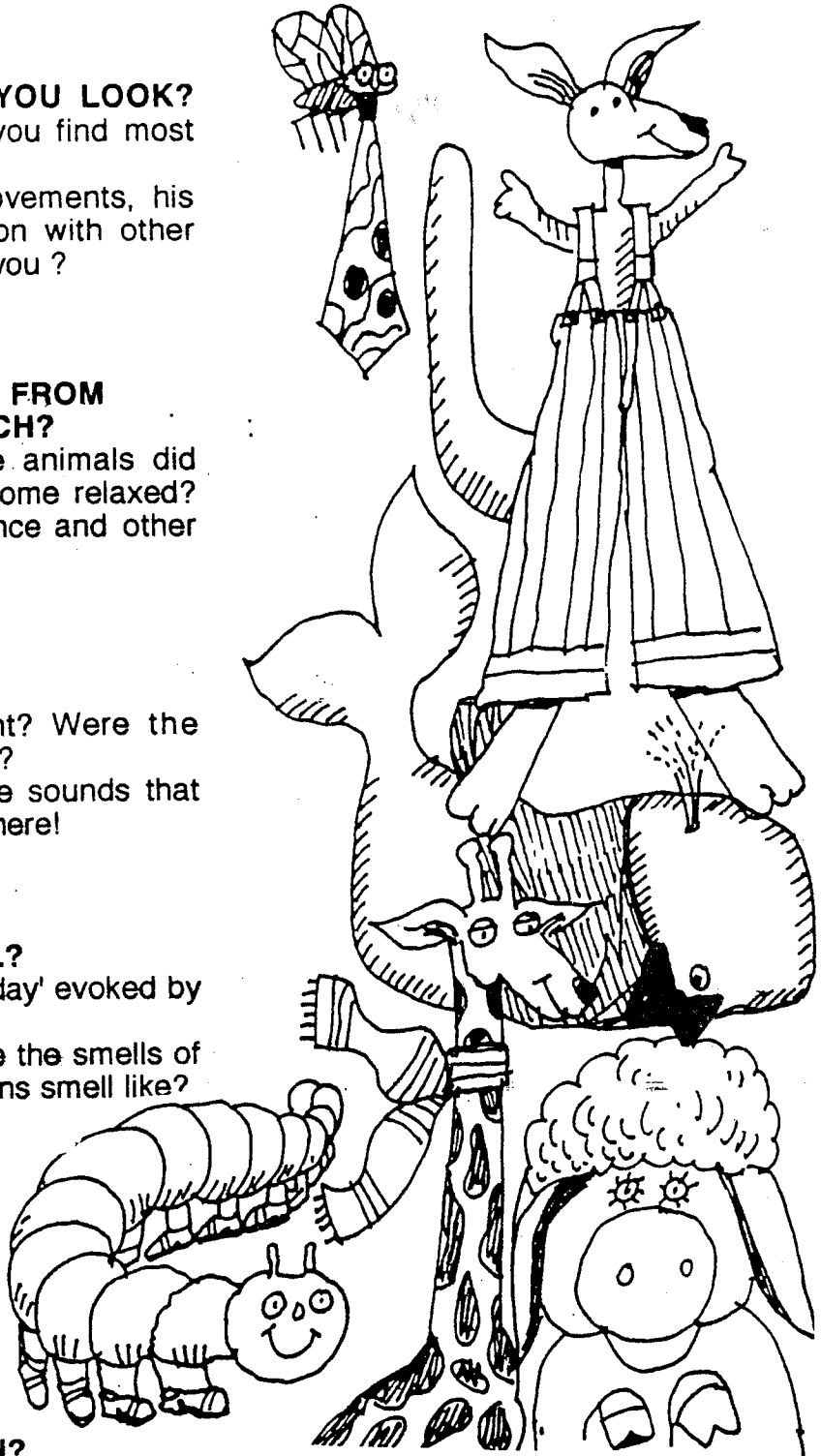
Which animals were silent? Were the human animals the noisiest?
